The Centre Superintendents of all the TTCs of AITT January/February 2019 are hereby informed that the theory examination for Dual System Training (DST) yearly pattern and semester system under CTS are being conducted simultaneously w.e.f. 30.01.2019 in two sittings.

In this connection, the following instructions are issued to be strictly adhered to by the Centre Superintendents of all the TTCs.

1. The Trade Testing Centre for both the examinations are same.
2. **The trainees fulfilling any one of the following criteria shall be eligible for appearing the theory examination.**
 - a) The trainees having valid hall tickets for those subjects mentioned in the Hall Tickets.
 - b) The trainees, who are not having valid hall tickets, but their names appear in the Form fill-up Data (Roll List) of the AITT January 2019. The Form fill-up Data (Roll List) of the AITT January 2019 has been uploaded on the Vidyarthi portal for reference.
 - c) In case the trainee is not having valid Hall Ticket and his name does not appear in the form fill-up list, but the Hall Ticket Generated status is YES in the Hall Ticket Eligibility Report.
3. The trainee has to produce any valid photo ID for his identification at the TTC.
4. No electronic gazette except calculator should be allowed to the exam hall.
5. The TTCs shall download the Descriptive Roll from the Vidyarthi portal.
6. The Attendance Entry and OMR No. entry to be done through the Vidyarthi portal by the TTCs.
7. After entry of attendance on the Vidyarthi portal, the packing slip will be generated.
8. Sitting wise OMR Answer Books of DST examination shall be packed superscribing on the top with red marker pen as AITT January 2019 DST MODE.



9. The OMR answer books of semester pattern examination shall be packed in one packet sitting wise irrespective of trades superscribing on the top with red marker pen as AITT January 2019 SEMESTER PATTERN.
10. The Engineering Drawing sheets of AITT January 2019 are QR coded, which contains data and can not be duplicated/ used during subsequent examinations, hence, the surplus ED sheets are to be returned to the Nodal Centres with proper accounts.
11. The Engineering Drawing sheets of each sitting shall be packed trade wise, ITI wise separately.
12. The sealed ED & OMR packets along with necessary reports of each day shall be deposited in the Nodal Centres positively by the TTCs within 2 hours from completion of examination.
13. ITC, Sundargarh, Kirei shall deposit sealed ED & OMR packets at the Govt. ITI, Jharsuguda. TTCs nearer to Govt. ITI, Anandapur shall deposit sealed ED & OMR packets at Govt. ITI, Anandapur and Tarini Institute of Engineering Technology & Management, Kandiahata, Rajkanika, Kendrapara shall deposit at Govt. ITI, Jajpur.
