





Whereas Students admitted during 2013-2016 batch in 1st semester were to appear the Examinations of different subjects with Full Mark 70 Marks and students admitted in 2017 batch were to appear the Examination of different subjects with same subject code as before, with Full Mark 80 Marks. This was causing difficulties in distributions of Question papers in Examination Hall as well as in Evaluations.

Considering the above difficulties, the Examination Committee of the council have decided to provide Question Papers having Full Marks as 80 Marks uniformly for the students of 2017 Batch as well as students admitted during 2013-2016 batch for the subjects with subject code remaining same. However, for the students of 2013-2016 batch, for whom the Full Mark should be 70 marks, their secured marks after evaluation shall be converted from, 'out of 80' to 'out of 70' marks with provision of Rounding of Marks to next integer if the effective marks secured is more than 0.5.


Further, there shall be one type of Question Pattern in Communicative English-I & Communicative English-II subject of both 2013-2016 and 2017 batch, which shall be of subjective type only and no MCQ type questions shall be set.

This is implemented with effect from Winter 2019 Exams onwards.
