6th Semester Summer Examination 2020 State Council for Technical Education & Vocational Training Odisha

Guideline and Requirement for appearing for Online 6th Semester Summer Examinations 2020

- 1. The students shall be allowed to appear in online examinations from their home using Laptop/Desktop Computer or Android based Smartphones/Tab with Internet connectivity.
- 2. Students who do not have or cannot arrange by themselves to have the above facility at their home or in vicinity or having internet connectivity problem may avail the option of visiting nearby designated Exam centre of their District or neighboring District whichever is convenient for them to appear in the said online Exams.
- 3. SCTE&VT shall identify preferably at least one such designated Exam Centre in each district of the state, which can be any polytechnic or Govt ITI.
- Eligible students willing to appear the 6th semester online summer exams 2020, as per above procedure, shall have to register in the web portal of SCTE&VT website from 15th July 2020 (10:00 AM) upto 21st July 2020 (6:00 PM) in order to appear the above online Exams.
- 5. The duration of the Examination shall be of 02.00 hours.
- 6. The examination shall consist of 100 (For Full Marks 80) Multiple Choice (MCQ), carrying 01 mark each.
- 7. Each MCQ will have 4 choices and a student shall mark his/her choice of answer for MCQs on the system itself.
- 8. Each student can attempt 80 (For 80 Marks) number of questions randomly selected from the question bank out of 100.
- 9. There will be no Negative Marking for any wrong answer or non-attempt, and answers will be auto calculated.
- 10. A student is allowed to take his/her examination during the period at his/her home or at his/her opted Institution here-in-after referred to as Center. However, s/he is not allowed to access internet or consult other people for any information during the whole time of examination session.
- 11. A student is not allowed to take photos or record videos of the exam and then share it with others. If found doing such activities, student would also be debarred from appearing further examination as per the rule and regulation of the Council.
- 12. A student has to indicate whether to appear the exams from Home or any Designated Exam Centre at the time of above Registration. In the case of later choice, he/she has to provide 3 Designated Exam Centre in order of preference. Ordinarily s/he shall be allotted any of the opted centres. But SCTE&VT is empowered to assign a centre other than his/her opted centres.
- 13. One shall go through **Annexure 1 Guideline for Registration Portal** for your easy reference.
- 14. Students can download their Admit Cards from Web Portal using their login, so as to appear in the Exams of different subjects scheduled on different date and Time.
- 15. The details of Schedule of Exams shall be published in SCTE&VT website. Students are advised to visit the website of the council regularly to get all the details including Timelines and updates.
- 16. The Online examination are tentatively scheduled in three batches (*Batch 1-* 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM; *Batch 2-* 12:30 PM to 2:30 PM & *Batch 3-* 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM) from **6th August 2020 to 20th August 2020.**
- 17. Non Payment of examination fee by the Institution by schedule date will make their student ineligible to appear the examination and they will not be issued admit cards.
- **18. Facility of Mock Test** shall be provided to the students in the portal to get acquainted with the method and pattern of the Exams from **25**th **July 2020 to 31**st **July 2020.**

- 19. There will be Generic Login ID and Password for all the students and students can login at any time, any place as many times as they want to appear the Mock Test.
- 20. Mock test is intended to familiarize students to the test environment an also validate the compatibility of the hardware. If a student encounters any technical issue, can contact technical support on the number to be notified in the website and Registration Portal for guidance. (Working Days(excluding Sunday)-10:00 AM to 6:00 PM)
- 21. <u>MOBILE PHONE FOR APPEARING EXAMINATION IS PERMISSIBLE</u>. But one should note that, while taking tests in tabs and cell phone, the navigation of images, if any, will be difficult because of screen size and <u>test will be interrupted when incoming calls arrive</u>.
- 22. Students are advised to login 10 minutes before start time to go through Instructions Page. But s/he will be only allowed to start the Test at the exact time of Batch Start Time. Students will be not allowed login of start the Test post 15 minutes of Exam Start Time(Ex. Login not allowed after 9.15 AM in a batch from 9AM to 11 AM).
- 23. After starting the Test, in case a student gets Genuine Disconnection from Server due to Power or Internet failure, in such case he/ she is able to login again after 3 minutes, the examination shall be resumed from the Instance of the Time of Disconnection. All his/ her previously attempted questions will be remain saved and he/ she can resume attempting further.
- 24. This is bare minimum configuration required for the Candidates to take the test successfully in their Desktop, Laptop, Mobile and Tab. RAM- Min 512 Mb, preferred 1-2 GB; Network bandwidth- Min 256 Kbit/s, preferred 512 Kbit/s. *Pop-up blocker should be disabled for the duration of the exam*. Any one of the recommended browsers should be available on the system (Latest Chrome Browser / Latest Firefox Browser / Internet explorer 8 or above) excepting Internet Explorer Edge browser. Adroid based Smart Phone of adequate memory and data pack/connectivity shall suffice the requirements. All the above browsers are required.
- 25. The candidate is advised to go through **Annexure 2 Guideline for Online Examination**; **Annexure 3- Copy of Instruction Sheet** & **Annexure 4-FAQ (Frequently Asked Question)** for your easy reference and guidance. *Annexure 2,3,4 shall be supplied in due course*.
- 26. Students shall have to visit the website https://sctevtodisha.nic.in/en/ and click the link on "Online 6th Semester Summer Exams 2020" for registration and appearing online Examinations
