

In response to earlier notice on online examination of 6th Sem Diploma, a number of queries have been raised by students and institutions on telephones which are repetitive in nature. The following points are hereby clarified with respect to the 6th semester online exams summer 2020 to be held from 1st to 20th August 2020(tentative).

1. The above online exams shall be conducted for 6th semester Summer Exams 2020 only.
2. Exams of other semesters are not covered in the said online exams. Details of Exams of other semesters (1st - 5th) including Back paper exams of these semesters, shall be intimated separately whenever decided.
3. Alternative mode of award of marks shall be applicable to both Regular and Ex-Regular candidates of 6th Semester Summer Exams 2020, who have no back paper in any of the 1st to 5th semester till date.
4. Regular students in 2nd and 4th semester who are eligible for movement to Higher semesters, as per Examination Rules and Notice No.5191 dt. 31.12.2018, shall be allowed to move to next higher semesters as soon as Academic session starts for 2020-21 session, even if Exams of the corresponding semester(2nd/4th) is not held before start of Academic Session.
5. If any District does not have Govt. ITI or Govt. Polytechnic to be used as designated Exams. centre then students shall be accommodated in Exams centres of neighboring districts.
6. If during examination, any district/area under which a particular Exams centre is located, is declared to be containment Zone, then SCTE&VT shall take steps to allow the candidates opted for that particular centre, to other centres in order of preference exercised by the candidate and in the worst case, to the other centres of the neighbouring districts. In such situation the candidate shall have to move to the newly allotted centre at his/her own cost to appear the test on scheduled date and time. Intimation shall be provide over registered Mobile Phone/Email etc.
