It is hereby informed that, 5<sup>th</sup> semester Online Exams shall be conducted as per the following programme.

1. Practical Exams shall be conducted in offline mode as usual from 21/10/2021 to 22/10/2021. Principals are required to make schedule for individual practical subjects. For the subjects of ED and Workshop of 2013 syllabus, the same principle adopted for 4<sup>th</sup> semester 2021 shall also be followed.
2. Theory Exams shall be conducted in 3 batches on 25/10/2021 and 2 batches on 26/10/2021 as per the following schedule.

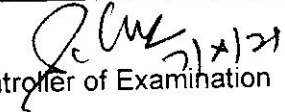

Candidates are further advised to get their **Battery of Mobile/Laptop/UPS etc. fully charged** and keep these devices connected to Power supply and keep them in charging condition to avoid power failure and Battery discharge condition, since Battery power is required to run for 2 Hours of Exams.

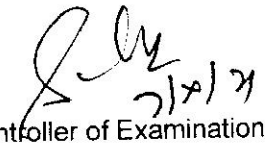

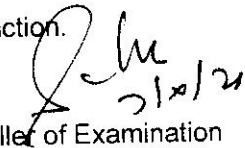
